

Toponymic analysis and cartography of Ivane Javakhishvili's "Map of the Republic of Georgia" (1922)

Annotation

The toponymic-geographical analysis-research and cartography of some toponyms of Ivane Javakhishvili's 1922 "Map of the Republic of Georgia" is depicted in the master's thesis.

As a result of the research, the significance of Ivane Javakhishvili's 1922 "Map of the Republic of Georgia" as a source of toponymic study was determined. The place of Georgian toponyms in the names of geographical objects was identified, their geographic-spatial analysis was carried out, the distribution areas were determined, their distribution according to opinions was discussed and some toponyms were classified, systematized and cartographed. Also, the geographical feature of the distribution of Georgian toponyms outside the new border of the Republic of Georgia, i.e., in historical Georgia, was analyzed.

It is worth noting that the peculiarity of the distribution of administrative-territorial units of Georgia was investigated and the comparison of the old with the modern ones, geographical objects were studied in terms of administrative units and their statistical analysis, and some of them were also characterized.

An analysis of the classification of some toponyms was sought, and some toponyms were classified and systematized in comparison with it.

Accordingly, it was established that the majority of toponyms in the territory of Georgia are Georgian, although the share of foreign layers in certain markets is also important; Also, within the framework of historical Georgia (Shavsheti, Klarj-e-ti, Erusheti,

Artaani), a rather significant part of toponyms is Georgian, which is indicated by the abundance of Georgian words and/or production of toponyms with Georgian suffixes;
